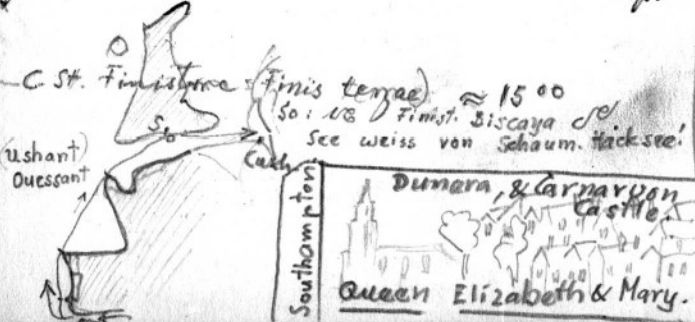
Bombay's Alexandra Dock. golden gate of India

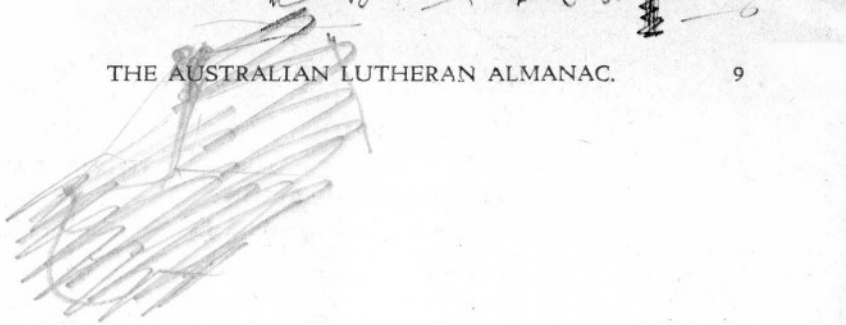
